Academic Qualification:

- M.D. (Radio-Diagnosis) / M.D. (Radiology) / DNB (Radio-Diagnosis) from teaching Institute recognized by NMC/MCI OR equivalent degree as per NMC/MCI.

Experience (as per NMC/MCI norms):

- A recognized broad specialty degree from a statutory university with 3 years' experience of residency in the concerned specialty while pursuing degree course.

Consolidated Remuneration:

- Stipend of **Rs. 1,10,880/-** per month.
- Additional research & academic scholarship (Including allowances) will be given as per the policy of the Institute.
- Leave, accommodation, Group health insurance and other benefits will be provided as per the policy of the Institute.
- They have to work every modalities of radiology department viz., USG, Mammography, X-ray, CT scan, etc. emergency duty, night duty, teaching, academic, training, research work & other work, as decided by the Institute. Duty (including VVIP duty) will be decided by the Institute.
- They have to abide by the rules (including discipline conduct rules) and regulations of the Institute & protocol decided by the institute.
- The appointment will be for one year from the date of joining. If the work of senior resident is satisfactory at the end of one year, as the case may be, his/her appointment may be extended for further one year.
- He/she may be posted (after appointment) at Satellite center of the Institute or any duty assigned by the Institute.
